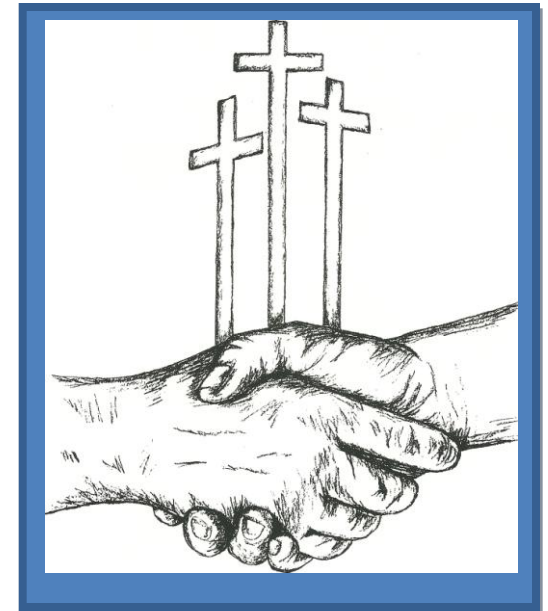

MEN IN BOATS Fishing Weekend

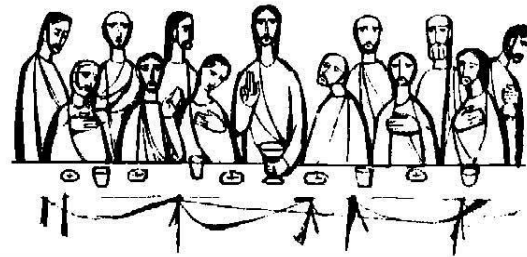

FAITH CHEST Woodworking Project

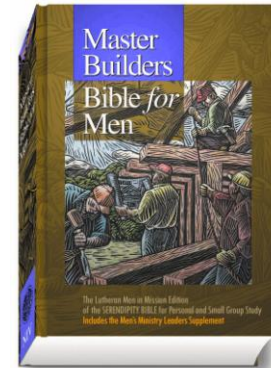
